Sub: - Implementation of freight rate for mineral carrying goods carriages

Sir;

I am directed to say that the freight rate for mineral carrying goods carriages was last fixed in the year vide this Department Notification No.5895/T., dated 07.09.2017 and was not revised till date. For the above reason, situation of conflicts between the Truck Owners and Industrial Units sometimes comes to the notice of Government.

In the mean time, the Transport Commissioner on the advice of Government has revised the freight rate vide his Order No.6772/TC/Tech dated 06.07.2021 (copy enclosed) taking into consideration the present diesel price.

You are, therefore, requested to take steps for strict enforcement / implementation of the above rate in your district so that there will be no such unto do situation in the district.

ORDER

In pursuance of Commerce & Transport (Transport) Department letter No. 2952/T dated 25.04.2017, Notification No. 5895 dated 07.09.2017 and Letter No. 5845 dated 29.06.2021 and due to increase in diesel price from Rs. 58.99 on 07.09.2017 to Rs. 97.45 as on 06.07.2021 by an amount Rs.38.46 rounded off to Rs. 38, the freight rates for mineral carrying goods carriages plying within and outside the Districts of Angul, Jajpur, Keonjhar, Sundargarh & Jagatsinghpur shall be fixed as specified in the tables given below and shall come into force from the date of issue of this order.

Note-I- The maximum freight rate as notified under column 4 Table-I & II above shall be applicable only for loaded trips from source to destination. The return idle journey has been compensated by allowing 40% extra.

Note-II - In respect of vehicles engaged in one way loaded trips for less than 50 k.m., maximum fixed charges for vehicle as a whole as in Col. -5 above would be paid on per day basis. This would be in addition to maximum variable freight charges for vehicles as a whole for one way loaded trip as in Col. 4 above.
