
Sir,

In enclosing herewith a copy of Govt. order No. 2115/C, Dt. 28.07.2015 of Home (Special Section) Department, Odisha I am to inform that the Director of Mines, Odisha in his letter No. 6473/DM, Dt. 31.07.2015 has instructed this office to suspend/ cancel the registration of Transporters and the Mineral Carrying Vehicles under i3MS who involve themselves to go on strike resulting in obstruction of mineral transportation by Road.

Therefore, all Transport Agencies registered under this circle should prohibit strikes for continuance of transportation of minerals uninterruptedly.

ORDER

No. 2115 /C, Bhubaneswar, dated the 28th July, 2015

It has come to the notice of the State Government that the Associations of Transporters, Loaders and Tippers of Keonjhar and Sundergarh district have gone on strike resulting in obstruction of the mineral transportation by road. Disruption in transportation of minerals is affecting adversely the local, State and National economy by impacting production, employment in Mines and end-users Industries.

Whereas the State Government are satisfied that in the interest of the public, it is necessary to prohibit strikes of the Association of transporters in the State in order to continue the transportation of minerals uninterruptedly.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Under Section 3(1) read with Section 4(3) of the Orissa Essential Services (Maintenance) Act, 1988 the Government of Odisha hereby prohibits strikes by any Association of Transporters, Loaders and Tippers in Odisha. The order shall remain in force for a period of six months with effect from the date of issue of the order.


