Learned Government Advocate to file detailed objections to the petition.

In the meanwhile, taking note of the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court through the order at Annexure - 'B', considering that the e-auction is to be conducted by the Monitoring Committee as directed therein and also taking note of the further direction that on completion of the e-auction, only 90% of the sale price would be paid to the buyer and 10% of the amount is to be retained by the Monitoring Committee towards the levies, ~~there shall be an interim direction to permit the petitioner to participate in the e-auction process without the pre-deposit of the royalty as demanded.~~ However, on the sale price determined in the e-auction and if the auction is finalized, the

Monitoring Committee is directed to recover the amount or such other amount representing all the levies including the amount payable towards the Mineral Exploration process and the District Mineral Foundation and only the remaining amount shall be paid to the buyer. The same shall however remain subject to the result of this petition.

ORDER

A memo is filed seeking certain corrections to be effected in the order dated 24.05.2016.

In the said order, the sale price to be paid has been mentioned as payable to the buyer instead of stating it as seller. Hence, in respect of the payments to be made, it shall be read as sale price to be paid to the seller. Further the ~~statutory levies to be collected shall also include NMET and DMF contributions.~~ Further, the amount recovered is to be paid shall be read as to the Mineral Exploration Trust instead of the word "process" that has been used in the order. Recovery of the statutory levies shall be in the same manner as has been ordered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court by the order dated 13.4.2012 to which the reference has been made in the earlier interim order dated 24.05.2016.

The clarifications made herein shall form a part of
the order dated 24.05.2016.
