## India 12<sup>th</sup> largest steel exporter in 2019

India was the world's 12<sup>th</sup> largest steel exporter in 2019. The country exported 11.8 million tonnes (MnT) of steel in the previous calendar, an 18% increase from 9.7 MnT in 2018 (including finished flats, finished longs & billets).

#### **Steel Trade Balance**

Over the past few years, India has alternated between being a net steel importer and a net steel exporter. Imports and exports have displayed a roughly inverse relationship. As per leading economists who have authored reputed columns, India is set to overtake Japan to become the second largest producer of crude steel in the world. After reaching 106 MnT at the end of 2018, the world's fourth-largest economy produced 110 MnT in 2019, quickly increasing by ~4%, as reported by the World Steel Association (WSA).

In terms of exports, the biggest buyers of steel from India are Vietnam, Nepal, Italy, the UAE, Belgium and steel contributes 60% of total exports.

India's major steel producers are the Tata Steel Group, Steel Authority of India Ltd. (SAIL), JSW Steel Limited, Essar Steel, JSPL and RINL. These are also recognised as the some of the largest export-quality steelmakers in the world.






#### **Exports to Top Markets**

Exports to India's top 10 steel markets represented 70% of India's steel export volumes in 2019 at 8.6 MnT. Vietnam was the largest market for India's steel exports with 2.36 MnT, a share of 20% in the total exports of 11.8 MnT in 2019 while exports to Nepal comprised 16% (1.9 MnT), followed by exports to Italy at 11% (1.32 MnT) of the total. Exports to the United Arab Emirates were 7.6% (0.9 MnT) and Belgium, 4.3% (0.5 MnT) of the total.


India exports steel to more than 180 countries and territories. The countries highlighted in the map below represent the top 15 markets for India's exports of steel and account for ~80% of India's steel exports in 2019.

Among the top 10 exporters in steel market Vietnam is the highest exporting country in 2019 recorded its export volumes at 2.4 MnT out of total export volume of 11.8 MnT. Followed by Nepal 1.9 MnT, Italy 1.3 MnT UAE 0.9 MnT Belgium 0.5 MnT, Sri Lanka 0.4 MnT, Malaysia, China, Spain and Indonesia recorded 0.3 MnT respectively.


#### **Trend in Exports by Top Markets**

Between 2018 and 2019, the volume of India's steel exports increased year-on-year to eight of the country's top 10 steel export markets. Exports by volume increased significantly to Vietnam, going up 394% to 2.36 MnT from 0.48 MnT in 2018, followed by Italy, up 55%, UAE up 29%, Malaysia up 23% and Sri Lanka up 77%.

However, export volumes to Nepal were seen to have decreased significantly by 10%. Exports to Belgium were down 24% and to Spain by 22%, while exports to Indonesia were down 6% and to the United States by 18%.

## **Top Markets by Steel Product Category**


India's top export markets by volume vary across types of steel products. In flat products –India's largest export category, Vietnam accounted for the largest share of imports in 2019 at 28%.

Around 36% of India's long products exports (0.35 MnT) were sent to Nepal in 2019. Nepal also accounted for 39% (0.96 MnT) of India's exports of semi-finished (billets) steel.

India's steel export volume was ~12% of its production in 2019.



While talking about production in steel market, volumes increasing consistently over the past 7 years. Share of export volumes have observed a sharp rebound after 2016, recorded a share of 15% in 2017 and dropped significantly with 9% shares in 2018. Percentage share of steel export in production is accounted 10% in 2019.

#### Imports by Top Market


Import volumes to India from the top 10 steel markets were recorded at 5.8 MnT in 2019. South Korea was the highest steel exporting country for India at 2.84 MnT in 2019, followed by Japan at 1.05 MnT and China at 0.97 MnT. Imports recorded from Indonesia were at 0.17 MnT, Germany 0.16 MnT, Russia 0.16 MnT, Taiwan 0.15 MnT, Singapore 0.12 MnT and Ukraine 0.11 MnT.

Among the top 10 importers in steel market South Korea is the highest importing country in 2019 recorded its import volumes at 2.8 MnT, followed by Japan 1.1 MnT, China 1.0 MnT Indonesia 0.2 MnT Germany 0.2 MnT, Russia 0.2 MnT, Taiwan 0.2 MnT, Singapore 0.1 MnT, Ukraine 0.1 MnT and Belgium 0.1 MnT.


#### Trend in Imports by Top Markets

Between 2018 and 2019, the volume of India's steel imports decreased by  $^{\sim}6\%$  to 6.44 MnT. Imports by volume increased a significant 7% from China to 0.97 MnT from 0.9 MnT in 2018, followed by Japan – up 6%, UK up 260%, Singapore up 54% and Russia up 23%.


## **Top Markets by Steel Product Category**

India's top import markets by volume vary across types of steel products. In flat products, India's largest import category, South Korea accounted for the largest share of exports in 2019, at 47%.

Around 22% of India's long products imports (1.1 MnT) came in from Singapore in 2019.




## India Top 5 Import Market by Product in 2019 [E]

Production of steel seem to maintain a consistent increase in volume over the past 7 years. However, share of Import volumes observed a sharp reduction from 2016, recorded a share of 8% and dropped significantly with ~7% shares in 2017 and 2018. Percentage share of steel export in production is accounted 6.77% in 2019.

# Steel Trade Report: Glossary



Export Market: Destination of a country's exports.

Flat products: Produced by rolling semi-finished steel through varying sets of rolls. Includes sheets, strips and plates. Used most often in the automotive, tubing, appliance and machinery manufacturing sectors.

Flat products HS codes (4 digits): 7208, 7209, 7210, 7211, 7212, 7225)

Long products: Steel products that fall outside the flat products category. Includes bars, rails, rods and beams. Used in many sectors but most commonly in construction.

Long products HS codes (4 digits): 7213, 7214, 7215, 7216, 7217

Pipe and tube products: Either seamless or welded pipe and tube products. Used in many sectors but most commonly in construction and the energy sectors.

Pipes & tube HS codes (4 digits): 7203, 7304, 7305, 7306

Semi-finished products: The initial, intermediate solid forms of molten steel, to be re-heated and further forged, rolled, shaped or otherwise worked into finished steel products. Includes blooms, billets, slabs and ingots.

Semi-finished (billets) HS code: 7207

Steel mill products: Carbon steel produced by either a basic oxygen furnace or an electric arc furnace. Includes semi-finished steel products and finished steel products.
